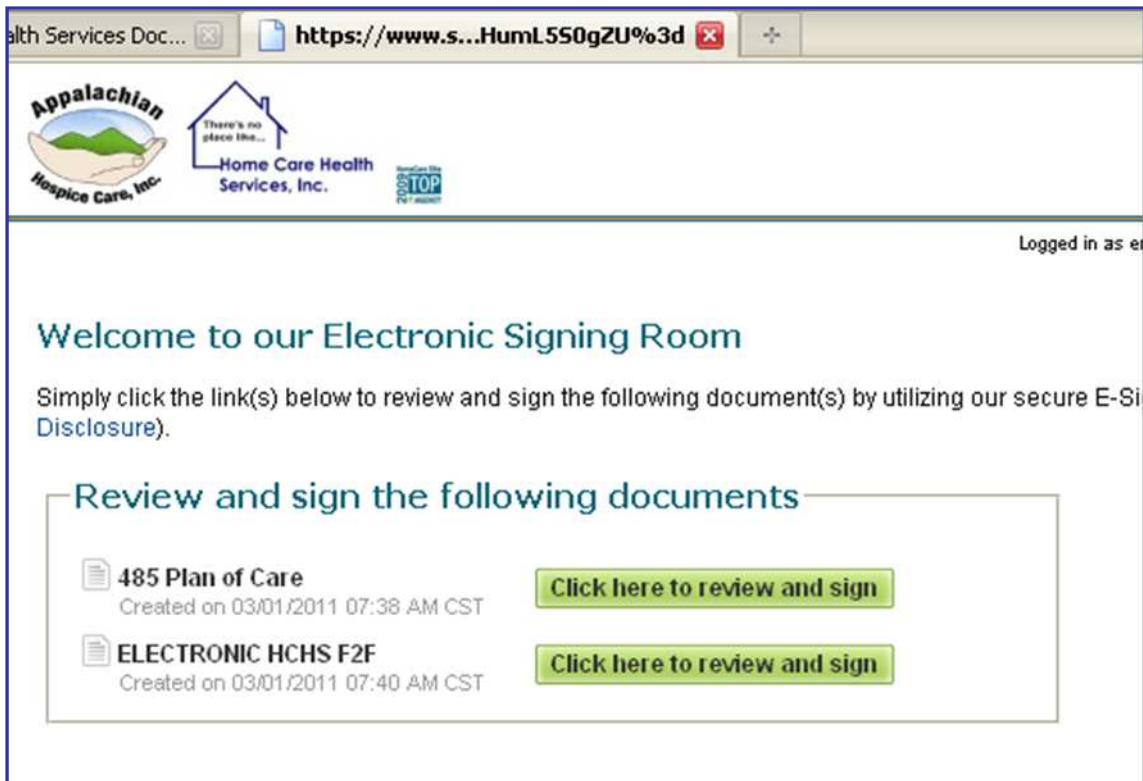




# Web Portal: eMedSign

## Electronic Signature & Online Forms

The optional eMedSign Agency/Physician Portal facilitates online review and signature of homecare orders and related certification forms through a HIPAA-compliant, agency-branded web portal. Instead of spending money and time on multiple faxes, mailings and office visits, with eMedSign all physician documents and communication are delivered and managed from your private, secure online portal “branded” with your agency’s name and logo.



### Benefits of eMedSign

## Simplicity for Physicians

- Meet 7-year retention requirement imposed by 2010 PPACA with electronic rather than paper storage of signed home care documents

## Meet the new CMS FTF rule

Adding the eMedSign option to your Horizon Healthcare solution can support meeting the Medicare requirement of documenting a physician's “Face-to-Face” encounter as part of the certification for home care services.

- When sending a Horizon-generated 485 to a Physician through your secure portal, you can send a Face-to-Face document as well
- Physicians will receive the fillable FTF form along with the 485, and when each is completed/signed they can be sent back to your portal, securely, in full HIPAA compliance
- Team members at the agency can verify completion and proceed with billing when both documents are returned
- Final versions can be off-loaded for electronic storage or printed for paper charting
